Golf Outing

The Wedgefield Homeowners Association will be holding its 9th annual golf outing on Saturday, May 3, 2003 at the Wedgefield Golf Club. This event has sold out every year since 1994. We invite all residents and non residents to participate. You need not be a good golfer to play.

The format this year is a Captain's Choice four person scramble. No green stings, no mulligans, absolutely no gimmicks!

Continental breakfast, range balls, green fees, cart and lunch are included in the entry fee. Cost is \$60.00 per person. If you are a WHOA member, cost per person is \$55.00.

Wedgefield Golf Club member with your own golf cart, cost is \$50.00. WHOA member who is also a Golf course member with your own cart, cost is \$45.00.

There will also be free ditty bags given to all players, plus cash prizes for men and women closest to the pin and longest drive. We also will have a new car available on a par three hole as a "hole in one prize".

Tickets are available to anyone interested in purchasing one or a dozen. Cost per ticket is \$10.00. Winner need not be present to win. You may purchase tickets without playing in the golf outing.
